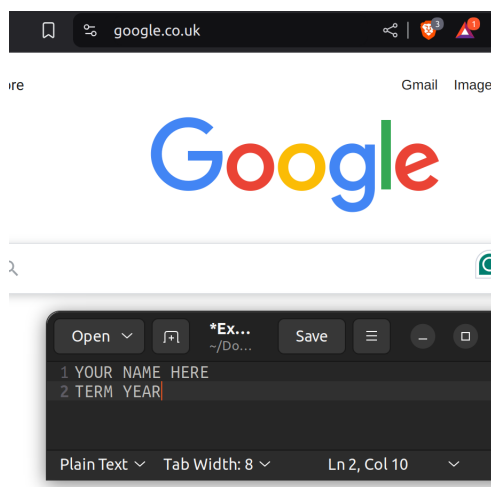


Figure 1: This is an image of what each of your screenshots should look like
